








Looking south from the intersection of Rioux Ct & Boyack Rd. Proposed installation will not be visible from this location.






Looking southwest from side yard of #2 Archer Dr.






Looking southwest from between #52 & #50 Oakwood Blvd. Proposed installation will be partially visible from this location.


